

Rights

1 First Amendment

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

A has a right	Meaning	Example
Liberty	A lacks obligations	competition
Claim	B has obligations	personal security
Power	A can change relationship with B	contract
Immunity	B can't change relationship with A	promise

3 Bad parent
