## 1 Instructions

- 1. By now you should already have a dataset to use.
- 2. Create a file called **index.htm** in your My Documents\ My Webs folder in your userspace.
- 3. You can edit the **index.htm** file using Word (remember to save as htm/html file).
- 4. Below I've listed the initial items to live on the website. They can live there via links or via text or anything fancier. To link to a word document or .pdf file, you put the appropriate file into your My Documents\ My Webs folder. Then highlight the text you want to act as the "link" and hit cntrl-K.
- 5. For the overall project, you will not be graded on the fanciness or the JAVAness of the website. However, you will be graded on the organization / structure / clarity of the website and what it presents to the viewer. It is entirely possible to use Word to create a well organized accessible presentation of the data and the analyses.
- 6. I do not necessarily want bullet points of the items below. Present the items in the way that you think is the most suitable for conveying the information to someone who is looking at the website. You might also include some kind of introduction or title for the website.

## 2 Things to have on your website (so far)

- The citation of the paper
- The abstract of the paper
- A description *in your own words* of the experiment undertaken to collect the data (maybe the description should come first???)
  - The goal of the experiment
  - The results of the experiment
  - The time frame of the experiment
  - Any flaws or weaknesses of the experiment
- A description of the dataset (like the email you sent me)
